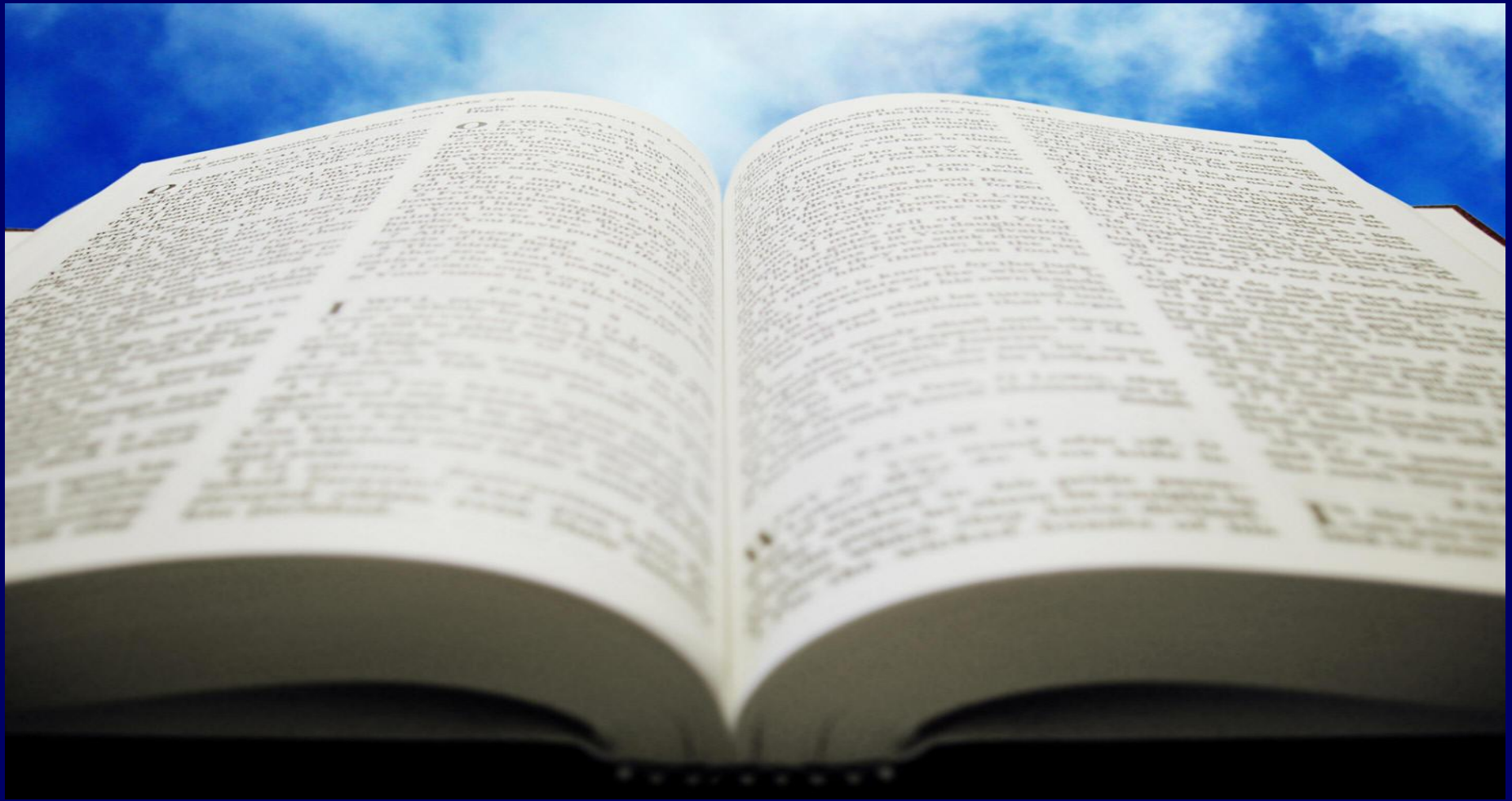

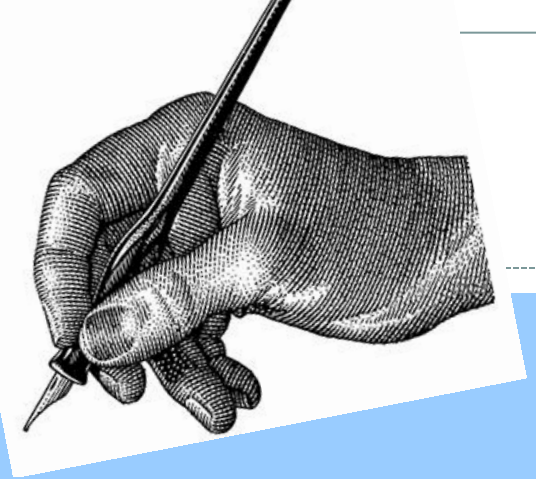

THE WRITER



- Luke, penned 2 NT books: LUKE & ACTS
- He was not one of the “12 disciples”
- He was not an eyewitness
- He was a physician
- He was also a historian

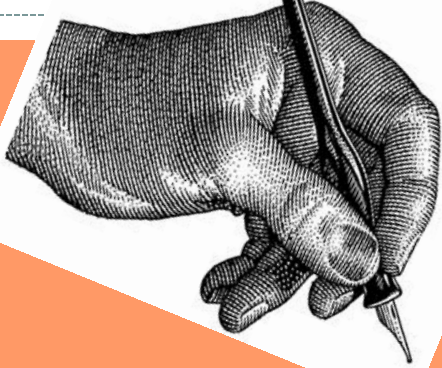


THE WRITING



- The longest of the 4 gospel accounts
- Luke and Acts form a sequence
- Written during times of:
 - ✓ Doubt for believers
 - ✓ Scandalous heresies
 - ✓ Wide spectrum of philosophies
 - ✓ Fight for power

THE WRITING



- Purposeful Writing

- ✓ To give an accurate historical account
- ✓ To strengthen the faith of the Gentiles
- ✓ To encourage faith in unbelieving Greeks

THE UNIQUENESS OF LUKE



❖ Details the account of His nativity

- Christ came to us
- Philippians 2:7-8

“...being found in the appearance of man”

THE UNIQUENESS OF LUKE



❖ Details the census in Judea

- He was numbered with the people
- Immanuel: “God with us”

THE UNIQUENESS OF LUKE



- ❖ Details the shepherds' visit
 - in the manger
 - bearing no gifts

THE UNIQUENESS OF LUKE



❖ Traces genealogy back to Adam

- Christ - the Perfect Adam, the Second Adam

THE FIRST ADAM	THE LAST ADAM
Living Being	Life-Giving Spirit
Comes from dust	Comes from heavenly

THE UNIQUENESS OF LUKE



- ❖ Details of Jesus' infancy and boyhood
 - 100% MAN
 - 100% GOD

18 are unique in Luke

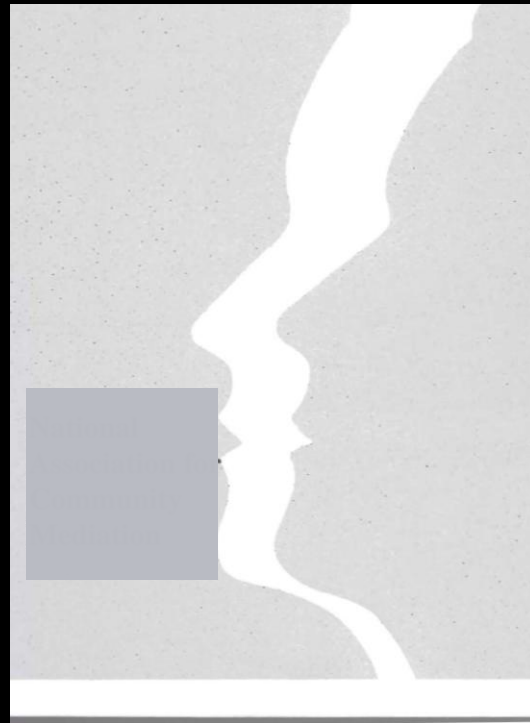
- 1) The Good Samaritan
